In order to utilize either the organ or the piano as a part of your wedding ceremony, the following guidelines have been established.

USE OF THE MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS:

If you wish to have the organ or the piano played during the service, the organist must be our staff church organist. If we are not able to play because of a schedule conflict, we will find a qualified and talented substitute.

APPROVAL PROCESS FOR WEDDING MUSIC:

We must approve all music selected for the service, regardless of the instrument(s) used, **NO LATER THAN TWO MONTHS PRIOR TO THE WEDDING DATE.** Neither the organ nor the piano will be available for use if you fail to meet the above-stated deadline.

Taped music is not permitted.

We look forward to working with you during this exciting time. These guidelines will help us in seeing that your wedding is a memorable one.
